Adrian was raised in Hempstead, New York, graduating from Hempstead High School in 1959. After which he enlisted in the United States Air Force and served until he was Honorably Discharged in 1963. He later enrolled in and graduated from Bishop College in Dallas, Texas in 1974. Furthering his education, Adrian received his Master of Social Work Degree from The University of Southern California in 1979. Upon completing his education

Adrian returned to New York and worked as a Social Worker retiring from the New York State Department of Social Services in the Spring of 2004.

In 1964 Adrian wed his first wife Louise Gusberti. Together they had one son Errol. In 1995 he married Shirley Wheeler whom he spent the remainder of his life with, raising two children, Shannon and Jeanine.
